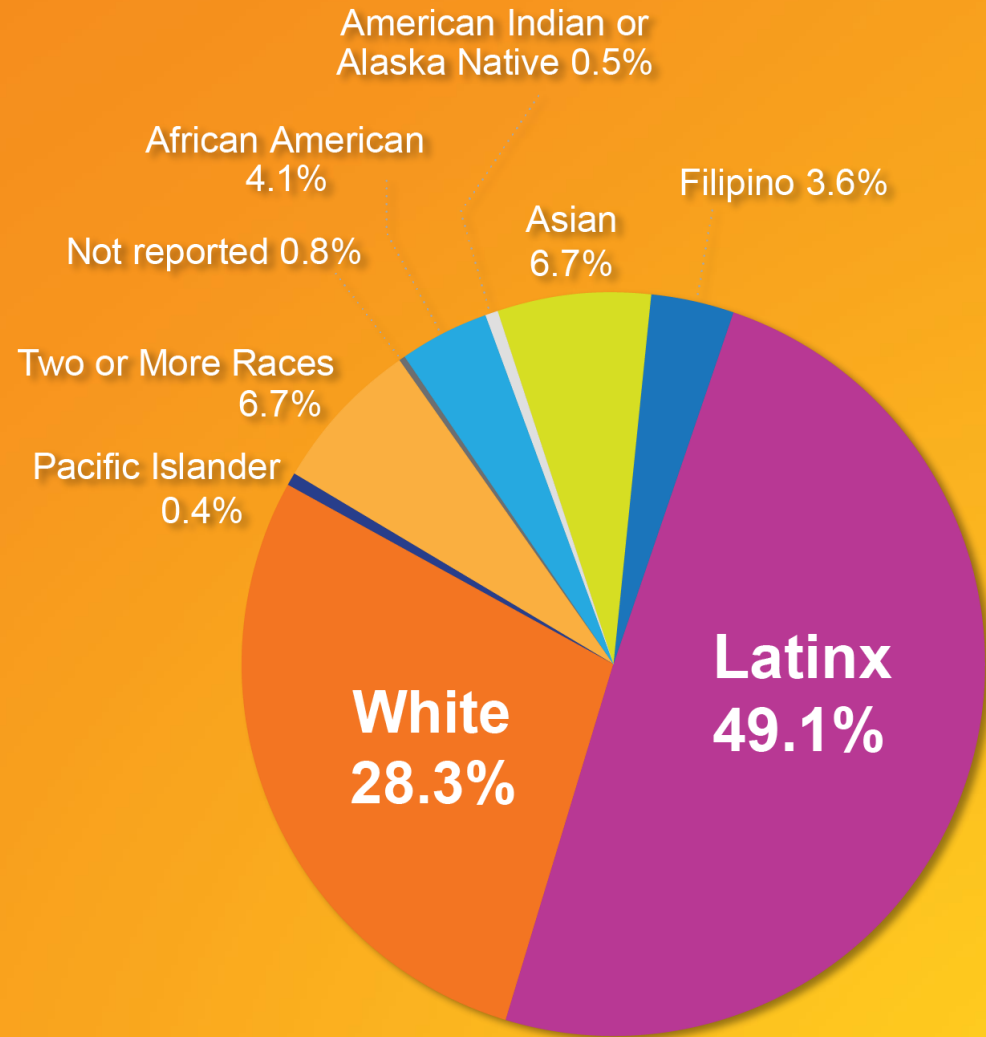

At the start of the pandemic:

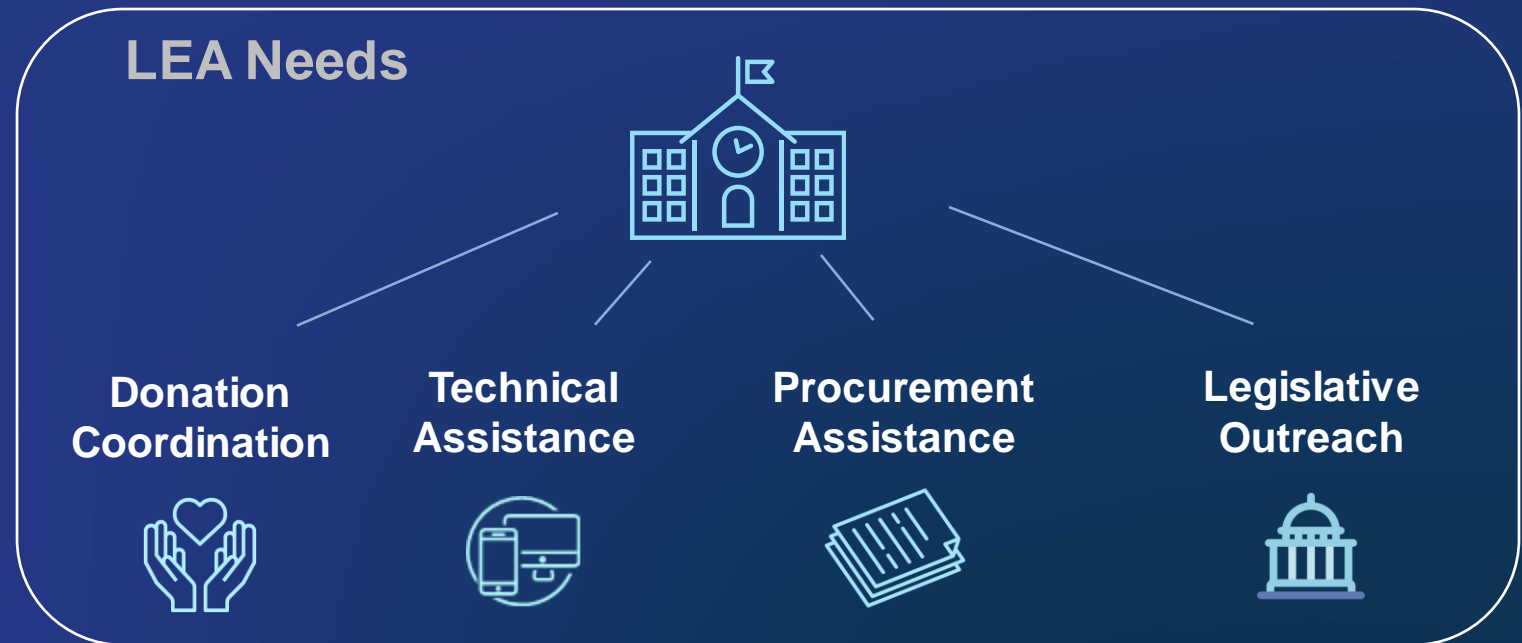


~100,000 students
